- Promoting the project, in order to attract more participants.

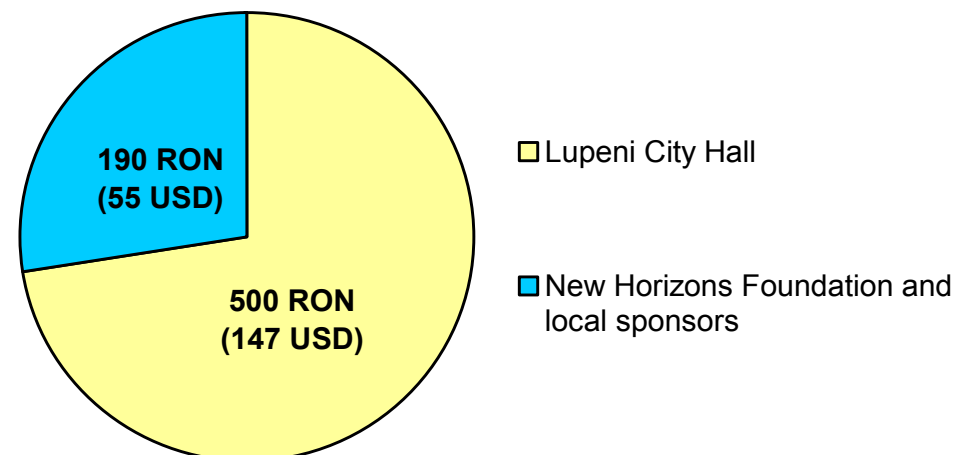
### Evaluation
